**The GRÜNE aim to gain a seat in the Kerzers Municipal Council.**

With three committed women, the GRÜNE are fielding candidates in the upcoming municipal council election in Kerzers. The candidates stand for fresh perspectives, constructive collaboration, and a policy approach that strengthens both people and nature.

Founded at the end of 2021, the GRÜNE Kerzers have since been an active, fact-based, and solution-oriented voice in local debates. To extend this approach to the municipal council, they will participate in the upcoming elections on 8 March 2026 for the first time. The three candidates, Evelyne Aubry, Dorothee Brumann, and Aline Ferreira da Silva, advocate for increased diversity, forward-looking policies, and enhanced sustainability in municipal decisions.

“Kerzers can do more” – enhancing quality of life, preserving nature, and strengthening community spirit. To ensure a community-focused and future-oriented development of Kerzers, the GRÜNE emphasizes these key priorities:

- Improving quality of life for all ages, providing affordable housing, and ensuring safe transportation options.
- Promoting biodiversity, conserving natural areas, expanding green spaces, and implementing sustainable land management.
- Developing a proactive climate and energy strategy that protects local resources and fosters opportunities for regional small and medium-sized enterprises.
- Strengthening community ties, promoting integration, and encouraging participation to help Kerzers grow cohesively across generations.

These priorities are intended to help make Kerzers resilient, vibrant and prepared for the future.

With their three candidates, the GRÜNE Kerzers want to strengthen diversity in the municipal council and win an additional seat for the left. They support political representation that listens attentively, fosters connections, and pursues fact-based solutions. They offer an integrated view of ecological, social, and economic issues and aim to lead Kerzers confidently into the future.
